Monday Update: Road Rage incident photos / video

The following update includes still images and a video clip of the road rage incident. The video clip has foul language and the audio may need to be cut out. The video clip is only a small portion of the incident and does not show the suspect shooting into the truck. We are requesting anyone who can identify the male and female in the attached still images to contact the Carteret County Sheriff's Office at (252) 504-4800.

We are requesting the still images be shown and the attached video can be shown at your discretion according to your own policies.

Previously Released 03/24/2013

On 03/24/2013 at approximately 1:00pm deputies responded to the area of Hwy 70 and English Street in Newport in reference to an incident of road rage that resulted in shots being fired.

Deputies are seeking information on a family of three including the driver, female passenger, and toddler that are accused of leaving the scene after the driver of that vehicle allegedly fired several rounds at the other vehicle.

The family wanted for questioning was said to have left the area in an ash or grey colored SUV. The driver of the SUV is being accused of road rage which started on Hwy 70 in the James City area in Craven County and ended in Newport in Carteret County.

Deputies are planning on releasing additional information in a news release tomorrow and are urging the family wanted for questioning to make contact with the Sheriffs Office prior to that information being released.
