Newport duo caught in the act

On 06-12-2011 Carteret County Sheriff's deputies arrested Jeremy Aycock, 26, of 2008 Hwy 24, Newport, and Danny Bradford, 24, of Clayton Dr, Newport after being caught burglarizing the Newport Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) post at 1316 Hibbs Rd in Newport.

Deputy James McClenny who was conducting a routine business check a little after 2:00am found the rear door of the building kicked in. As Deputy McClenny continued to investigate further he heard movement inside the building and called for backup.

As one of the suspects exited the building holding stolen merchandise he was held at gunpoint until other deputies could arrive. Deputy Stephan Gaskill and Deputy Keith Moore arrived on the scene and secured Bradford. The building was searched and Aycock was found hiding in a closet and resisted arrest while being taken into custody.

Aycock and Bradford were both charged with Breaking & Entering & Larceny, Damage to Property, and Possession of Stolen Goods. They are both being held in the Carteret County Jail each under a \$10,000.00 bond.

This is the second time Aycock has burglarized the same Newport VFW. Aycock served time in prison for the December 15, 2005 B & E & L of the VFW post. He served his time in the Department of Corrections starting 05/02/2006 and was released 12/15/2006. Both men are currently on probation.
