Missing Person - Update

The Carteret County Sheriff's Office is seeking help from the public in locating a missing 90 year old woman whose house also caught fire on Thursday, September 20, 2012. Goldie Gilliken Hall, 90, of 2065 Hwy 24 in Newport was reportedly last seen on Wednesday, September 19, 2012, at her residence in Broad Creek.

Fire officials responded to a 911 call that the residence was on fire and were able to contain the blaze. The fire mostly burned the kitchen area of the house and the remaining portions of the residence are still intact. An extensive search was completed of the residence and surrounding property but authorities are still unable to locate Ms. Hall.



Ms. Hall is a white female, 5'02", approximately 100 lbs. Ms. Hall is believed to be wearing a red and white shirt, red pants and unknown color shoes. Ms. Hall is not operating a vehicle at this time.

The North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation's Arson Unit was called in to assist with the origin and cause of the fire. An aerial search was conducted by the North Carolina State Highway Patrol and Carteret County Emergency Management issued a "Delta Alert" in attempt to locate Ms. Goldie Gilliken Hall.

The fire and whereabouts of Ms. Goldie Gilliken Hall are still under investigation.
